We are looking for a highly motivated individual with a strong background in neuroscience and master's degree or equivalent in neuroscience or closely related disciplines. The position is associated with the **Research Training Group 2413 SynAGE** (www.synage.de), supported by the German Research Foundation. Initial funding is for 3 years, extension possible.

The research project will address the role of the hippocampus and its long-range interaction with anterior cingulate in performance monitoring and error detection during learning. We are particularly interested in the role of local hippocampal circuits and their changes in response to stress and ageing.

The ideal candidate is experienced with maintenance of mouse colonies and the in-depth behavioural characterization of (mutant) mice. Additional expertise in molecular and biochemical techniques, immuncyto- and histochemistry, microscopy, or electrophysiological methods is beneficial. We expect a strong motivation to learn new methodologies and the ability to independently plan, conduct and analyse experiments and to prepare the results for publication.

The successful candidate will work in an interdisciplinary environment and an international team. For more information see www.storklab.de. English proficiency is mandatory.

The candidate will be given the opportunity to develop a doctoral thesis with intensive mentoring and support through the RTG SynAGE and the CBBS graduate program of the Magdeburg neuroscience community (see also <u>gp.cbbs.eu</u>).
